The Economic & Social History of Scotland is proud to announce a new biennial essay prize in memory of **Alastair J. Durie**, who was renowned for his work on the history of Scottish textiles and tourism. Winning essays will be awarded £250 and be considered for publication in the Society's *Journal of Scottish Historical Studies*.

Postgraduate and early career researchers are encouraged to submit essays on any aspect of the economic, cultural, or social history of Scotland and the Scottish people. Each entry should be between 8-10,000 words in length, inclusive of footnotes and appendices. Entries should also conform to the JSHS general submission guidelines, which can be found on the **Edinburgh University Press** [website](#).

The deadline for all submissions is **30 January 2021**.

Entrants will be notified of the outcome by 30 June 2021.
